We are very excited and we hope you are too. Here is some important information:

Dates/Time: Monday, July 9th – Friday, July 13, 2018, 8:30am to 3:30pm (extended day until 5:00pm)

Location: Hopkins Academy, Russell St., Hadley

Please arrive a few minutes early the first morning to sign consent forms. Items that we need before the beginning of camp are:

- 1. Camp health form (please download from our site)
- Immunization record (Included on the medical form)
 (If your child is unimmunized, we need a signed waiver written by parent/guardian)
- 3. Camp pick-up form (please download from our site)
- 4. Tuition: \$275 \$325(extended). Please bring a check if you haven't already sent your check by July 5th.
- 5. If you have applied for scholarship, the results will be announced on June 15th. (Application Deadline June 30th)
- 6. All forms can be located on our website (www.MyMobileSoccerAcademy.com), under the CAMP tab, click on "more info" on our camp page, then "Important Forms". Let us know ASAP if you need assistance.

Find below everything you will need to know about camp. Be prompt as we have a very full schedule planned for the week. No tuition refunds or portion thereof, upon withdrawal from camp for any reason, including sickness, injury, or dismissal.

All campers must bring a soccer ball (preferably size 3) and full soccer gear (cleats and shin guards) daily. Please be kind t your feet. Do not wear your cleats from home. Carry your cleats and ball in a bag, and change when you arrive on the field. As you leave the field, we recommend your changing back to your regular shoes.

What to bring:

- 1. Bag for equipment
- 2. Ball
- 3. Shin guards
- 4. Socks
- 5. Cleats (very important: all shoes should be broken in)
- 6. Indoor soccer shoes
- 7. Towel
- 8. Insect repellent
- 9. Sun Block.
- 10. Water bottle

Drop off /Pick-up time:

We will need names, addresses, and phone numbers of people who can pick up your child at camp. Please provide us with that information on the "Pick Up List Form" below. We will keep this on file at camp and require children to be signed out.

Medications:

If you will be sending prescription or "over-the-counter" (OTC) drugs/medications with your child to camp you must also:

- 1. Send the drugs/medications in the original container bearing the pharmacy label, which shows the prescription number, date filled, name of prescribing practitioner, name of medication, direction for use and cautionary statements, and name of patient. (All "OTC" medications must be in the original container containing the original label.
- 2. Parents must provide a picture of their child and affix it to the outside of the medication container.
- 3. Fill out a written permission slip authorizing the administration of the drugs/medication to the camper by camp staff/trainer signed and dated by you.
- 4. Include written instructions for the use and administration of the prescription or "OTC" drugs/medications. These need to be legible and understanding.

NO REPACKAGING OR PRE-POURING OF MEDS ALLOWED.

All medications will be stored in a closed container at camp and administered by health supervisor.

Camper may be allowed to self medicate only if:

- Prescribed Epi-pen or inhaler
- Blood sugar monitoring and insulin self-injection.
