Policies, Procedures and Safety

Compliance

 This summer camp sponsored by "My Mobile Soccer Academy" complies with the regulations of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health and is licensed by the local board of health and is also registered to operate. All staff is required to undergo a CORI (criminal record) and SORI (sex offender) background check.

Safety

- Safety is of utmost importance to us. We will do our best to ensure the safety of
 each person and will expect the same from all the campers. While we want to
 have fun at camp, we also want to make sure that camp is safe and enjoyable for
 all! We ask campers and staff to always be aware of others to avoid unnecessary
 injuries. Running a structured and organized camp will help to ensure the safety
 of all.
- Staff will take into account the heat and weather each day. Indoor space will be available, if necessary, in the case of extreme heat or heavy rain/thunderstorms. Campers will also be given several opportunities to cool off in a shady space.
- Campers should bring water bottles, however, water will be available and numerous water breaks will be given throughout the day. Campers are welcome to get water whenever they feel necessary as well.

Policies:

• Campers should arrive in the morning wearing sunscreen. There will be extra sunscreen available to re-apply if necessary, or in the case that it has been forgotten at home.

- No camper will be allowed to leave the grounds of Hopkins Academy unless prior arrangements have been made or in case of medical necessity. Campers will be at all times in view of the group or accompanied by a staff member at any location. If a camper has medical diagnosis/allergies that we should be aware of, the staff should be alerted prior to the first day of camp.
- We assume that all campers are willingly attending camp and come with a positive attitude. We expect campers to be respectful of both the staff and other campers. Disrespectful campers will be re-directed and/or spoken to as a reminder. If this type of issue is persistent and the verbal reminder does not seem to resolve the problem, parents will be notified and the camper will not be invited back to camp. Unfortunately, no refunds will be given in this case. No camper will ever be subjected to severe punishment, humiliation or verbal abuse. We strive to make this a fun and friendly environment for all. Please let us know if your camper has any concerns whatsoever.

Parental Consent:

• (You will be required to sign a copy of this consent form at check-in) I have read and accept the policies and procedures used at My Mobile Soccer Academy Summer Camp to ensure the safety of my child. I am aware that accidents do happen while participating in sports. In case of an accident or injury, I grant permission for the applicant to be given treatment at a local hospital, and I will assume all responsibility for payment of any costs incurred. I will not hold the KidsAfrik, My Mobile Soccer Academy organization and/or Hopkins Academy liable for such accidents. I agree to pick up my child in case of disciplinary issues or illness. If I am not available, an emergency contact person will be available.
